# Spring Hanging Basket FUNDRAISER



**Fuchsias** like to be in a shady location, either no sun or morning sun only. A full-grown plant will need to be watered every day. A hanging basket on a very hot day will appreciate water twice a day. If the direct sun is not on them, shower the leaves too. If the plant looks droopy, it needs to be watered.



**Wave Petunias** like plenty of water, full sun, and a careful watch for the petunia budworm (actually a caterpillar), which eats the blossoms.



**Ivy Geraniums** grow like ivy, spreading and trailing into long cascades or compact mounds. The blossoms are full and abundant, with semi-double or double flowers, depending on the number of petals. Like all geraniums, they do best in sun, but can also tolerate some shade.



**New Guinea Impatiens** like partial sun and needs moderate moisture
