Professional Activities of Staff

- KHS Universal Team
 - Universal Team- continues to meet biweekly looking at Data that relates to school climate including attendance, student discipline, student/staff perceptions, academic achievement
 - Class meetings continue to reinforce our SOAR principles (Service, Ownership, Adaptability, Respect)
 - Students are now involved in running parts of class meetings with the goal of having an even greater role in these important community building meetings
