Professional Activities of Staff

- KHS Administrative Restructure
 - Change in positions of Vice Principal and Student Advocate/MWV Academy Director
 - New Positions are Dean of Students 9-10 and Dean of Students 11-12
 - Rationale- Creation of administrative structures to support curriculum development, instructional practices, and better serve the student population at each grade level.
- Multi Tiered Systems of Support
 - Universal Team- met over the summer several times
 - Developed Universal Expectations for students and staff
 - SOAR- Service, Ownership, Adaptability, Respect
 - Apply in all locations and events
 - Expectations- Being taught universally through our advisory model
 - Goal for this current year will be to use student data to reduce student discipline referral by 25% through positively impacting behaviors in the classroom, as well as all other locations within the school
- Advisory- First 3 weeks of school students have been meeting with the advisory classes daily before the flex period begins.
 - Department Heads worked to develop lessons for each advisory period
 - Connected to the SAU 9 Portrait of a Learner with a focus on the tenant of Character for this school year
 - Lessons have been taught universally and have worked in collaboration with the Universal team
