Professional Activities of Staff

- Program of Studies Redesign
 - Principal, Career Tech Director, and Dean 9-10, and Dean 11-12 are collaboratively working to update both the format and content in the KHS Program of studies.
 - Program of studies is going through a redesign to create a streamlined document that will be user friendly and interactive
 - Work on scope and sequence of programming to fit the 9-10 and 11-12 grade-span model to help create pathways that will drive student choice and success
- Alternative Program Development
 - Development of an alternative program for students that are struggling and/or credit deficient has been cooperatively developed with KHS and Resonant Learning Center and the first students are beginning to access it.
- School Counseling Department
 - Class meetings were held on December 5th with all Juniors, and the Sophomores that elected to take the PSATs to discuss results, what the data means, steps for growth, and next steps related to the SATs
 - Conducted class meetings with Seniors regarding scholarships and the process for applying for them, deadlines, specific details on how to use the online platform.
- KHS and WMCC Partnership
 - Ongoing meetings are occurring with White Mountain Community College to enhance our collaboration to offer increased opportunities to students to gain early access to college through running start, dual enrollment, E-start, and other means to provide as many possible opportunities for students at KHS in all academic areas
