## **Professional Activities of Staff**

- KHS Universal Team
  - Created and Implemented SOAR at KHS
    - Service, Ownership, Adaptability, Respect
    - Started Monthly Student Meetings
    - Identified Targeted areas for school improvement
    - Re-wrote behavioral expectations to be more student friendly and with teacher interventions for many behaviors
- KHS Leadership Team
  - Created advisory structure with grade level advisories and are leading development of advisory programing
  - Led the KHS teachers in embedding the SAU 9 Portrait of a learner, with a focus this year on Character
  - Instrumental in helping drive the redesign of the KHS Program of Studies, but more importantly looking at the scope and sequence of classes. Next Steps development of exploratory pathways, as options for students

- Student Service Coordinator- Student Work Experiences
  - This position works with students in our RISE program and other students that receive special services and provides opportunities to work in the greater MWV community.
