Professional Activities of Staff

- Alternative Program Development-
 - Program continues to move forward
 - Lead teacher position is posted and first candidate will be brought in
 - Locations are continuing to be explored both on Conway School grounds and off
 - Plan for identification/recruitment of students will start shortly
- KHS Universal Team
 - o Summer Work- review of previous years work and next steps for the current school year
 - o Continued Developed/Revisions to Universal Expectations for students and staff
 - SOAR- Service, Ownership, Adaptability, Respect
 - Last year focused on assembly and restroom spaces, continue this and move to new areas
 - Expectations- Being taught universally through class meetings, advisory, regular classrooms, and individual one on one interactions
 - Goal for this current year will be to use student data to reduce student discipline referral by 25% through positively impacting behaviors in the classroom, as well as all other locations within the school
- Advisory- Continuing single grade level advisories
 - Adoption of the One Trusted Adult Branch Out Curriculum for the current school year. There will be 4 years in total of curriculum through One Trusted Adult
 - All staff previously read this book and new staff have been provided with copies of it
 - Curriculum has been purchased by the NH Department of Education and is available for all high schools in the state

 - 260 students are participating in fall athletics (20 more than last year)
