

Kennett High School Principal's Report December 11, 2023

Professional Activities of Staff

- KHS Universal Team
 - A Schoolwide Meeting is being held Friday, December 8th. Students from our Student Council
 and Student Ambassadors have collaborated to create the agenda for the first school wide
 meeting
 - Focus on improvement of the physical environment of the cafeteria for students. Exploring
 multiple options including colors, background music, creating a space for student artwork,
 seating options. Looking both short term quick items as well as long term items which will take
 more time and planning
- School Safety-
 - Creating a KHS Safety Committe to look at school safety at KHS. Will be made up of KHS admin, teachers, Safety Coordinator, School Resource Officer and local law enforcement, and other membership as necessary
 - All KHS students were shown a video on ALICE and its tenets. We will be having additional drills related to school safety.
- Illustrative Math Training-
 - Teachers participated in IM Training on 11/27 doing instructional rounds and observing Conway staff implementing specific IM lessons and then debriefing on what was observed. The next series of instructional rounds will be with just KHS Math Teachers observing lessons being taught by members of our own math department.
