Professional Activities of Staff

- KHS Alternative Program- Students began meeting with the lead teacher prior to the start of semester 2. Currently there are 8 students enrolled in the program for part of their school day, with regular meetings with the lead teacher over the course of the day. Additional students are being met with to determine if the program is appropriate for them.
- KHS Universal Team- continues to work to support creating universal expectations for students and staff
 - We will be looking at pulling data from multiple areas to identify where we would like to put focused attention school wide.
- Math Department
 - Illustrative Math Training- Professional Development was held on February 5th and 6th with teachers in grades 6-12 participating in collaborative lesson planning and feedback on the lesson
 - Will be holding SAT prep sessions during flex for any students that would like to participate. This will run through our administration of the school day SATs in March
- NEASC- The NEASC 5 year and special report have been completed and submitted for review. Our next report will be the 7 year report and then we will begin the process of going into the next round of self study after that

- Athletics
 - Kennett Fights Cancer Hockey Game was held on Saturday, February 3, 2024. Over \$14,000 was raised to support KHS student Parker Kurze and his family, as well as Jen's Friends. In the 5 years of doing this more than \$60,000 has been raised to support families in the Mount Washington Valley
 - The Girls 4X160 relay team has broken the school record multiple time this season, with the current record being 1:28:94
 - Aida Wheat has broken the individual school record for the 300 meter event with a time of 43:74
 - Ski teams (Alpine, Nordic, and Jumping) are heading into their championships and we hope to bring home more championships in these fields.
